



Application Process and Costs

- 1. Applications for amnesty will commence in April 2022.
- 2. Applicants must go online to www.immigration.gov.bz to download application forms and make an appointment to submit completed applications.
- 3. After application has been submitted, an electronic receipt will be given where you can check the status of your application.
- 4. If your application is approved, you will then need to pay the Government of Belize \$500 per applicant 18 years or older and \$250 per applicant below 18 years of age.

REQUIREMENTS

General Requirements for all applicants:

- Completed Permanent
 Residence Amnesty
 Application Form
 Belize Police Record
- for applicant and children 12 years and older
- 3. Personal identity document, translated to English (expired ID or passport accepted)
- 4. Medical Certificate
- 5. HIV, VDRL, and TB Laboratory tests for adults and children 12 years and above
- 6. Two passport sized photographs
- 7. If dependents are included, complete dependent section on the form and submit letters of financial support for each dependent.

NB: Only one application form per family; accompanied by form for dependant.

Qualifying Criteria and Specific Requirements:

1. REGISTERED AS ASYLUM SEEKERS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF REFUGEES



Must have been registered before 31 March 2020



Must have an official letter from the Department of Refugees signed and sealed by the Director of Refugees and addressed to - Director, Nationality and Passport Department, Belmopan.

Qualifying Criteria and Specific Requirements:

- 2. RESIDING IN BELIZE
 BEFORE 31ST DECEMBER 2016
 3. HAVE AT LEAST ONE (1)
 CHILD BORN IN BELIZE ON OR
 BEFORE 31st DECEMBER 2021
 4. COMPLETED PRIMARY,
 SECONDARY AND OR
 TERTIARY EDUCATION IN
 BELIZE
- 5. MARRIED TO A CITIZEN OF BELIZE FOR AT LEAST ONE (1) YEAR.
- 6. IN COMMON-LAW UNION WITH A CITIZEN OF BELIZE FOR AT LEAST FIVE (5) YEARS 7. REFERRALS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES (MINORS/ADOLESENTS AND VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING)
 8. MAINTAINED GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT IN BELIZE FOR

FIVE (5) YEARS
