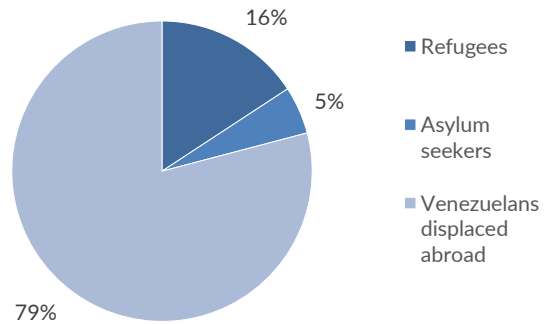
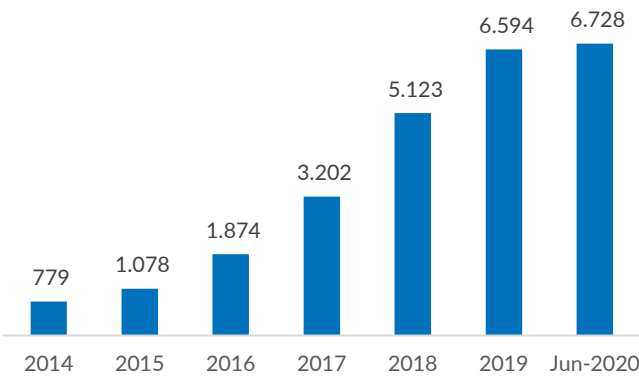

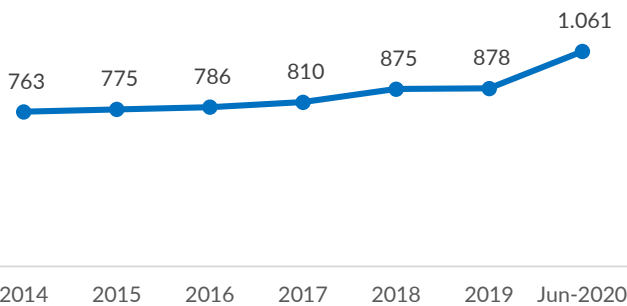

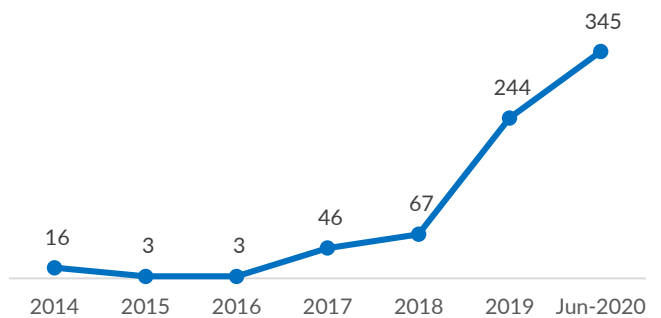
Population of concern

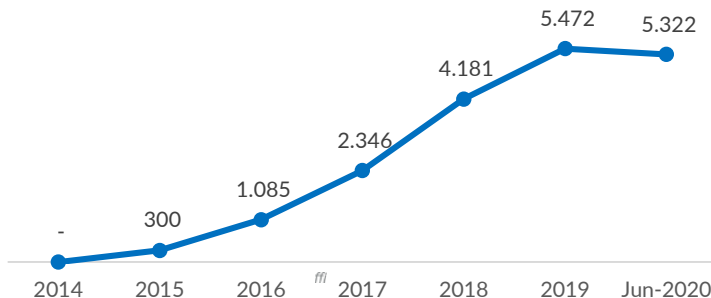

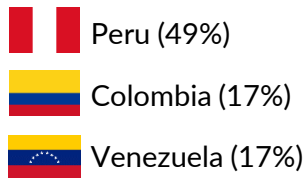

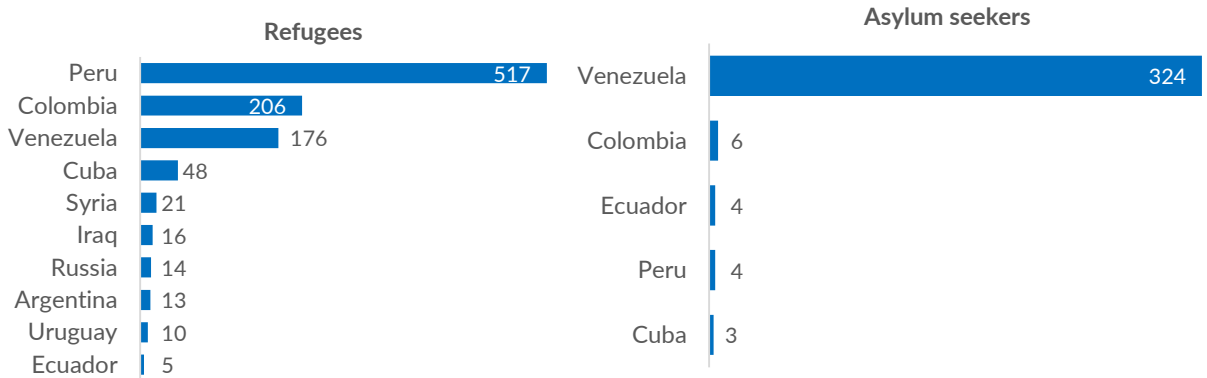

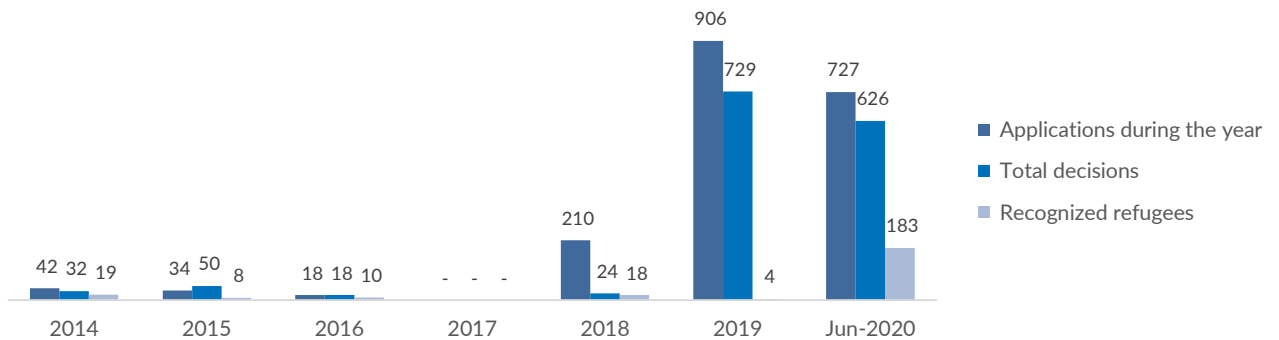
